In November 2017, ATSIP started to be indexed in Engineering Village (EI). EI is comprised of several databases, including the Ei Compendex, in which ATSIP is now indexed. Ei Compendex is an engineering literature database containing over 20 million records from 77 countries across engineering disciplines. The 2017 APSIPA Annual Summit and Conference (APSIPA ASC 2017) was held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, during 12-15 December, 2017. This is the ninth annual conference organized by APSIPA, and 334 papers were accepted for presentation from 27 countries. The conference attracted papers on all aspects of signal and information including signal processing, recognition, classification, communications, networking, computing, system design, security, implementation, and technology with applications to scientific, engineering and social areas.

To introduce state-of-the-art techniques in signal and information processing, seven tutorials, six invited overview talks, four keynote speeches, an education forum and an industry forum were organized in APSIPA ASC 2017. 
