This year, we received 279 submissions (138 regular session papers and 141 special session papers) from authors of 19 countries. We are pleased to let you know that the quality of the submissions were outstanding, and around 78% of the total regular submissions (108 submissions) are accepted to be presented in the conference. In summary, we have 108 general session papers and 134 special session papers. This year, we prepared sufficient conference rooms and all papers can be presented in oral. The words "Recognition, Detection and DNN" are quite big (except for speech and image), which shows their popularity and important in recent days.



To introduce and discuss the state-of-the-art signal and information processing technologies, we prepared 2 tutorials, 11 invited overview talks, 3 keynote speech, and industry forum. We would like to express our appreciation to the keynote speakers, forum guest speakers, invited overview session speakers, tutorial presenters, reviewers, session chairs and all authors for their contributions to APSIPA ASC 2016.
